








Typical old packet boat passing New Orleans. This type of steamer has almost disappeared from the Mississippi.




Walls of first state capitol of Kansas still stand at Ft. Riley.



C. L. Hicks, champion bull rider, spends his prize money for an improved Ford Touring Car.









at Nebraska City, Nebr.










Scene in Highland Park plant showing machining of armature for turbine Generator preparatory to installation in the Twin City plant of the Ford Motor Company.
